Here's how you can get involved and connect with the youth...

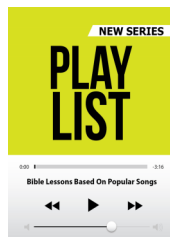

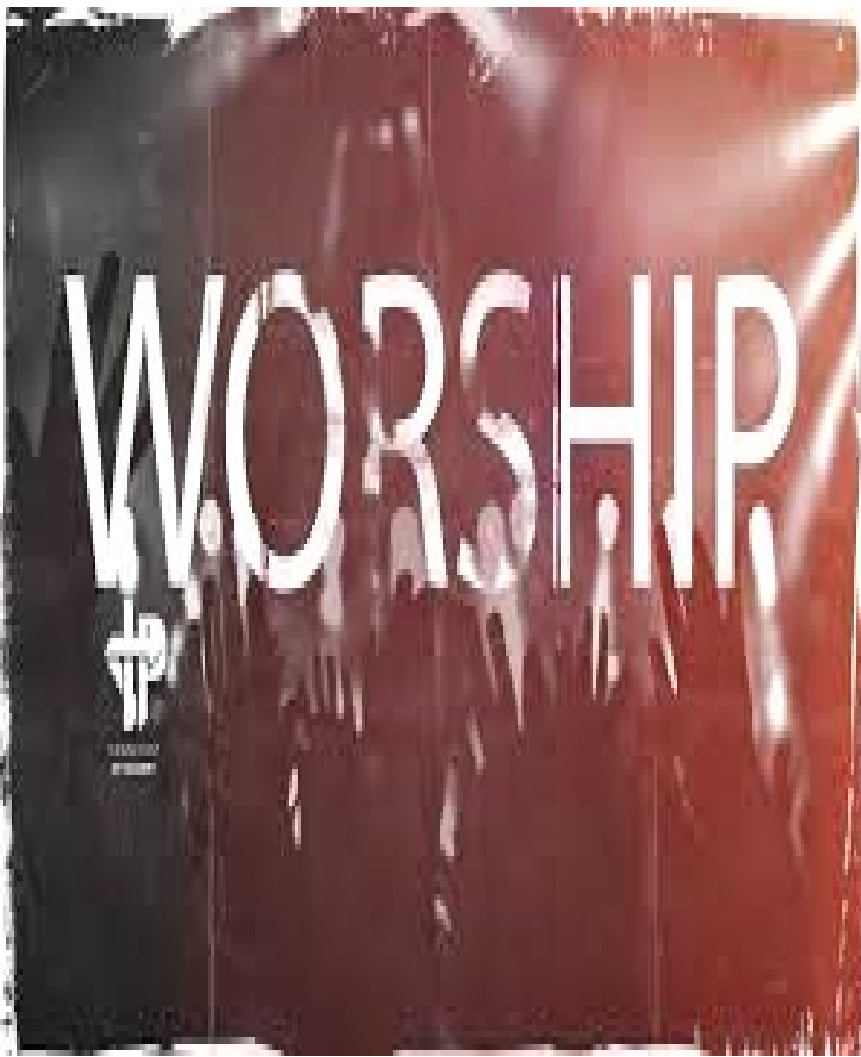
